

ORDINANCE NO. 96-9

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CURFEW IN BEAR RIVER CITY, UTAH.

A. IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS TO BE OR REMAIN IN OR UPON ANY OF THE STREETS, ALLEYS OR PUBLIC PLACES OR VACANT LOTS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF BEAR RIVER CITY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF TEN O'CLOCK P.M. AND FIVE O'CLOCK A.M. THE DAY FOLLOWING, UNLESS SUCH PERSON IS ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT, GUARDIAN OR OTHER PERSON HAVING LEGAL CUSTODY OF SUCH PERSON OR UNLESS SUCH MINOR'S EMPLOYMENT OR LAWFUL BUSINESS MAKES IT NECESSARY TO BE UPON THE STREETS, ALLEYS OR PUBLIC PLACES BETWEEN THE HOURS SPECIFIED HEREIN. ON FRIDAY AND SATURDAY NIGHTS OF EACH WEEK THE HOURS SHALL BE TWELVE O'CLOCK MIDNIGHT TO FIVE O'CLOCK A.M. THE DAY FOLLOWING, PROVIDING ADEQUATE TIME FOR SUCH MINOR PERSONS TO ATTEND SCHOOL, CHURCH OR CIVIC FUNCTIONS PROVIDED FOR SUCH MINOR PERSONS.

B. IT IS HEREBY UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PARENT, GUARDIAN OR OTHER PERSON HAVING LEGAL CHARGE OR CUSTODY OF ANY PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS TO ALLOW OR PERMIT SUCH MINOR PERSON TO BE IN VIOLATION OF SECTION A WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF BEAR RIVER CITY, UTAH.

C. ANY PERSON VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE.
